I have read the following:

The therapist is obliged to act in accordance with legal regulations. The rights and obligations of the client and care provider are recorded in the Medical Treatment Contracts Act (WGBO) and the Care Quality, Complaints and Disputes Act (Wkkgz).

### Privacy

- The therapist keeps a client file. The client has the right to inspect her/his own file. The file is kept in accordance with the legal retention period for a total of 20 years.
- There is a right of access for next of kin.
- The therapist will provide information about the treatment to the client at all stages of the treatment. The client will provide relevant information to the therapist through the anamnesis interview.
- The therapist maintains confidentiality related to information provided by the client, which is stored in the file.
- The therapist may not perform any specific treatments or treatments without the client's consent. Information for statistical purposes shall not be used without consent of the client.
- The therapist will refer client to a fellow therapist or a doctor if treatment is deemed not appropriate and / or insufficient.

## **End of therapy**

- Termination of the treatment can be done by mutual consent at any time. If the client terminates the agreement against the advice of the therapist, the client will sign a statement at the request of the therapist in which she/he indicates that the examination or treatment is prematurely terminated contrary to the advice of the therapist.
- The therapist can terminate the agreement unilaterally. In such a situation, the therapist will continue to provide help and advice until the client has been able to conclude an agreement with another care provider.

## **Rate**

- The client agrees to the rate of € 75,- for the first consultation and intake interview and to the amount of € 75,- per session thereafter.
- An invoice of the sessions will be sent by e-mail at the end of the month.

## **Reimbursement of the therapy**

- Not all health insurers reimburse treatments. Client is to contact the health insurance to find out if and to what extent the rate is covered by insurance.
- Client is to send the invoices to her/his health insurance and keep a copy.
- If the appointment is not cancelled a day before (minimal 24 hours), the reserved time of the appointment will be charged.

## **Liability**

- The therapist has a collective professional liability insurance. For complaints about the treatment, the client can turn to [www.nvagt-gestalt.org](http://www.nvagt-gestalt.org) for the right of complaint and the TCZ Foundation, Disciplinary Law Complementary Care ([www.tcz.nu](http://www.tcz.nu)) for the right of complaint.
- The withholding of information present in the medical file from the general practitioner is at the responsibility and expense of the client.
